The air-conditioned lounge has dual aspect, allowing for plenty of light and bay breezes, with access to the huge outdoor undercover entertainment area... perfect for family gatherings!

The kitchen is the centre point between the lounge and the air-conditioned family/dining area, with a large window, and door access to the undercover area.

All four bedrooms are good sizes with built in wardrobes and ceiling fans. The master ensuite with air-conditioning has external access to the undercover entertainment area. Bedroom 3 has double doors opening to the family/dining room, plus external access to the entertainment area. Bedroom 4 also has air conditioning.

There's almost 5 KW's of Solar power to minimize costs, plus insulation in the ceiling.

In addition to the double garage with automatic door you have side access to a powered double bay shed with door openings of 2.6 meters and 2.8 meters, so bring your caravan/ boat. The huge yard provides plenty of space for kids to play and room for a pool. There's also a garden watering system to keep your flowerbeds looking good all year round.
