With soaring cathedral ceilings and a contemporary palette, the main living zone draws you in, where extensive glass invites a wash of natural light, framing panoramic views that shift with the day. The heart of the home, a striking stone kitchen, beckons with its waterfall-edged island, glass splashbacks, and a 900mm freestanding oven. Here, cooking is an experience, as the butler's pantry keeps everything tucked away, and a gas log fire warms the expansive family/dining area that opens to private decking. From sunrise over the national park to evening views of urban lights twinkling below, every moment is a treat for the senses.
