- The Distillery: Equipped with both a 100-litre and 10-litre still, this facility complements the existing business opportunities on the property. It offers further potential for those looking to explore the growing Tasmanian spirits market.

- Picker Huts: Two original picker huts, adding additional storage or the potential for other commercial uses, further enhance the estate's versatility.
