Entry is via the original front door. Downstairs offers a sizeable multiple-purpose room with high ceilings and exposed brick, ideal for a fourth bedroom or guest room. Climbing the feature staircase, you are greeted with floor-to-ceiling windows and a glass entry to the main level with the original elegant stairwell pendant light - a statement piece. The blackwood kitchen has been modernised, and its layout is super-functional and equipped with quality appliances. Across the hallway is a well-designed butler's pantry/laundry combined. It is such a clever use of space with outdoor ramp access. Stepping into the living room, you are taken aback by the uninterrupted panoramic views across the River Derwent, extending to the city, mountains, and Bruny Island. The wrap-around patio with a glass balustrade is designed to enjoy the views and picturesque surroundings.

The bedrooms are generous inside, with the Master enjoying the river and mountain views on one side and the other opening onto a private courtyard overlooking the swimming pool. This room displays beautiful internal brickwork and an ensuite with a walk-through wardrobe, all enhanced by a skylight. The other two bedrooms offer built-in robes and look over the pretty gardens. The skylight in the main bathroom adds a bright and airy feel, with a mid-century-designed shower over the sunken bath.

There are many outdoor rooms to discover, such as a hidden vegetable garden, the BBQ picnic area, an undercover paved courtyard, a secured pool area, and so many more...

This delightful property is completed by the downstairs double garage with internal access, an ideal space to create more living space if required. There is also ample off-street parking available for a boat or a caravan.
