Ornate archways, honey toned timber floors and wood heaters set within the decorative fireplaces are further cherished features to note.

The thoughtfully designed floorplan features five generous bedrooms, each with its own distinctive colour scheme, serviced by a new central bathroom. This bathroom boasts a deluxe clawfoot bath and stylish black and timber-finished cabinetry.

The north-facing 'L-shaped' kitchen, dining and living area is the true heart of the home and is perfect for gatherings, large or small.

The chef's kitchen stands out with a full-length bench, central island with seating for four and high-end appliances, including a stainless-steel Westinghouse 90cm dual fuel oven.

Ducted heating and split system heating and cooling alongside double glazing ensures year-round comfort.

Outdoors, entertain on the paved courtyard and enjoy the lush, private garden, inviting adventure for children and pets.

The property excels in infrastructure with two large sheds for farm and horse equipment.

Equestrians and hobby farmers with be impressed with the 20 acres of well-fenced paddocks and 60x20m riding arena.

The six paddocks, equipped with auto-filled water troughs, include various sizes and additional features like electric fencing, two post-and-rail horse yards and a walk-in shelter. An 89-meter bore supplies water to all troughs and garden taps.

Enjoy friendly neighbours, a tree-lined street and a nearby park. With bus stop from Romsey and Lancefield and milk bar within walking distance, and easy access to Romsey, Lancefield, Sunbury, Kilmore and Kyneton, convenience meets charm.

Melbourne Airport is a 35-minute drive, and the MCG is just an hour away, making city trips simple and accessible.
