Having views of Matchbox Range, mains power is connected and 18 solar panels feed power back to the grid reducing power bills by heaps. There are 3 brms and an open plan kitchen, dining & lounge room. This living area has a slow combustion wood heater. You have two sunrooms, and the bathroom & toilet are combined. Out back is a large undercover area great for entertaining. Hot water is electric & there is heaps of rainwater storage totalling approx. 16,000 gallons all up.

Off to one side of the house is a good-sized shed with concrete floor, used for machinery & a work area. There is also a garden shed and a large, enclosed vegetable garden.

Ranging between approx. 25m & 40m above sea level, there are two dams and good firebreaks & tracks making it easy to drive around. Approx. 10 acres has been cleared & planted with mango trees, the remainder of the block is timbered.

Bitumen road to within 4km of the property, mail is delivered 5 days a week and rates are approx. \$1,100 per year. Both primary & high school children can catch the school bus out front. Telstra mobile reception is good and the home has the landline connected as well.

Approx. distances: Baffle Creek facilities 20km, Agnes Water 30km if you have a 4WD and go through the Deepwater National Park otherwise to go by road you are looking at 69km, Bundaberg 105km, Gladstone 110km.
