With a total of four sleep sanctuaries throughout, each space has been individually curated, while the common denominators are plush carpet underfoot and block-out roller blinds for a restful night's sleep. The expansive master suite enjoys a built-in robe and private ensuite, while bedrooms two through four are each fitted with a built-in robe.
